

### BUDDHA PURNIMA

- Buddha Purnima, also known as Buddha Jayanti, is an auspicious day that marks the birth anniversary of Gautam Buddha, the founder of Buddhism.
- It is believed that this was also the day he attained enlightenment.
- Every year the Purnima tithi in the Hindu month of Vaisakh is observed as Buddha Purnima.
- Buddha Purnima falls on a full moon night, usually between April and May



### SIGNIFICANCE

- As per the religious scriptures and mythological stories, Lord Buddha was born as Siddhartha to King Shudhodhan and Queen Maya.
- People believe that He was born in Lumbini, Nepal.
- Hindus have immense faith in Lord
  Buddha and observe Buddha Purnima
  with utmost devotion. People often
  observe the day by taking part in the
  early morning prayers and yoga.
  Siddhartha became Gautam Buddha
  after attaining enlightment under the
  Bodhi tree in Bodh Gaya,Bihar.

WHILE EVERYONE IS ASLEEP.




#### THE ENLIGHTENMENT

#### · THE FIRST SERMON


DHARMACHAKRA PRAVARTANA- BUDDHA

### DEATH-MAHAPARINIRVANA

HAVING ACHIEVED THE GOAL OF SPREADING THE TEACHING TO THE GREATEST NUMBER OF PEOPLE, BUDDHA DIES AT THE AGE OF EIGHTY YEARS, AS A RESULT OF FOOD POISONING. HE DIES IN A FOREST NEAR KUSINAGARA, INDIA, IN THE COMPANY OF HIS FOLLOWERS RECLINING ON A BED WHERE HE SPEAKS HIS LAST WORDS: "ALL COMPOUNDED THINGS ARE EPHEMERAL; WORK DILIGENTLY ON YOUR SALVATION." WITH THESE WORDS ON HIS LIPS, HE PASSES INTO THE STATE OF NIRVANA.

Suffering has an origin.


Nirodha

## MIDDLE PATH

The Middle Way or the Middle Path is well known in Buddhism. It is called Madhyama pada in Sanskrit and Majjhima pada in Pali. The Buddha coined this word to suggest a way of life that embodied His teaching and emphasized the virtues he believed would lead his followers to Nirvana or the cessation of being and becoming.

- BUDDHA TREATED WOMEN EQUALLY.
- BUDDHA BELONGS TO THE SAME DYNASTY AS OF LORD RAMA-IKSHVAKU.
- SUPPOSEDLY, BUDDHA'S TOOTH IS STILL AROUND TODAY. IT WAS REMOVED DURING HIS CREMATION CEREMONY AND SMUGGLED INTO SRI LANKA WHERE IT IS STILL PRESENT TODAY.
- BUDDHA'S SPOT OF ENLIGHTENMENT UNDERNEATH THE BODHI TREE IS STILL PRESERVED TO THIS DAY.

# DID YOU KNOW?



- UNLIKE MOST RELIGIONS OR SPIRITUAL BELIEFS, BUDDHA'S TEACHINGS WERE SPREAD BY NONVIOLENT METHODS SUCH AS WORD OF MOUTH OR CARVINGS ON PROMINENT STONE BUILDINGS.
- BUDDHA TAUGHT AND TRAVELED HIS ENTIRE LIFE UNTIL THE AGE OF 80 WHEN HE PASSED AWAY. HIS FINAL REQUEST OF HIS FOLLOWERS WAS THIS: "ALL COMPONENT THINGS IN THE WORLD ARE CHANGEABLE. THEY ARE NOT LASTING. WORK HARD TO GAIN YOUR OWN SALVATION."
- THE TERM 'BUDDHISM' WAS COINED BY WESTERN SCHOLARS IN THE 1830S. BUDDHISTS DON'T ACTUALLY REFER TO THEIR RELIGION AS "BUDDHISM.
