Play and Experiential Ways of Learning

Play and experiential learning along with different stages and types of play are beautiful natural ways of constructive learning. It is imperative to look at play from the very beginning in a child's life. Is it something that one imposes or induces or is it something that is natural, self- driven and mentored?

How does it help us to learn and why is it important to talk about it?

Babies just open their eyes and start looking outside in the environment they are born into; they start exploring gradually through all their sense organs and the learning starts, is it not natural?

If children are given a natural freedom to explore through different stages of learning, they will grow by learning at each moment. Play can become a part of their learning in school going years also, where sometimes the style of education is imposed on a child. It is important for children to learn through natural ways in a constructive manner so that their learning can be developed, and they can enjoy the process of learning. Here a significant role of experiential teaching comes in. A teacher is there as a mentor, providing them with an environment where independence is given in a natural surrounding with many objects around.

Learners would like to interact with the environment where a mentor is there to hand hold and peers are there to collaborate. They can learn by exploring sand, pots, water, balloons, squeaks, bottle covers, water pipes and everything around and this will turn into reflection-based experiential learning in a constructive way.

Let us take a small example of learning about parts of the body. Children were taken to a place with mirrors around them and were given paints, clay, ice cream spoons, colour pens, crayons, pencils. While playing around if they suddenly looked into the mirror or when they were putting paint on each other on different body parts, it led to learning about one another and also led to learning about different body parts like face, hand, legs etc. Here an adult plays a great role - while looking into the mirror , the child is looking at himself or herself, a mentor or a parent can say "wow, amazing, your eyes are so beautiful!" this will develop knowledge about body parts with a positive image and children will be motivated and happily move forward with their learning. They grow to love themselves and they learn to appreciate their peers too. Later, they reflect and learn that they are different from one another. Children enjoy these learning experiences and they construct meaning which may be goal oriented as per age. The role of a mentor here can be of providing them the right environment and also hand holding during learning, instead of driving them through. To conclude, it can be said that play is a journey of learning which involves developing each day rather than reaching a fixed pre-determined destination.

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
A Trip To The Moon

Caring for Rabbits

I have two rabbits Jincy and Laila. One is male and the other one is female. I learned a lot of things about rabbits with my mother. I am sharing a few important points on rabbits, based on my experiences -

- Keep rabbits, cage free. There are two reasons for keeping rabbits cage free. Firstly, they need a lot of space to run and hop. Secondly, they also need physical exercise.
- In case you wish to cage them, then make sure that the cage is a large one, so that they can roam around freely in the cage. To make sure the floor is soft, keep a soft mat inside the cage. Remember to take them out occasionally and do not put the rabbits inside the cage all the time.
- A rabbit's main diet includes 90 % of hay or fresh green grass and 10% of pellets. Vegetables like carrots and the fruits like bananas are just the right treat for them. It can be given only once a week. You can also leave some green leafy vegetables near them.
- Rabbits are self-grooming animals; thus, they do not need a bath daily.
- We should cut their nails and comb their body regularly.
- As they have long ears, their hearing is very sharp. We should avoid loud noises near them as they get scared very fast.
- Rabbits can be toilet trained and taught to use the litter box. If rabbits litter anywhere else by chance, then we can clean it with the tissue paper and put the tissue in their litter box. They will then smell their litter in the tissue and use the specified area each time.
- For making their litter box, take a small cardboard box in which your rabbit can fit. Put dry grass in the box for comfort. Please clean the box every two days.

Please do not buy rabbits, adopt them instead.


Avengers


