We are happy to inform you that Genesis Global School is organizing its third edition of the artist camp from **11th April to 13th April, 2018**, featuring five eminent artists, Mr. Shyam Sharma from Patna, Mr. Yusuf from Bhopal, Mr. Nawal Kishore from Ghaziabad, Mrs. Annu Naik from Delhi and Ms. Bandana Kumari from Bhopal. These artists will demonstrate their techniques by producing paintings and prints in the school in front of the students.

The first edition in 2015 of the Artist Camp featured the following eminent artistes:

- Kishan Ahuja - Delhi - Printmaker, painter and also photographer, he has successfully synthesized the abstract values, enriching them with the figurative motifs that convey a deep emotional content.
- Nirensen Gupta - Delhi- His works are aesthetic expressions of his inner reflections infused with serenity, sacrifice, service and beauty.
- Ashok Hazra -Ajmer- believes 'Changes in forms and themes remain a part of the process, but the underlying note or mood in all my works is the feel for everything Indian.'
- Deepika Hazra - Ajmer- Themes based on peacocks, women and nature convey her love for brush and colours.
- Chandan Choudhary - Patna- expresses his inner feelings and joy of life as he sees it- the color, the innate grace, the unaffected beauty of simple folk and their surroundings has been the desire of him artist from an early age.
- Jagdish Dey - Delhi -Earlier his paintings were transformed landscapes, based on his flights of fancy and now he paints man and woman in a variety of moods with peacocks acting as a means of communication.

The second edition in 2016 featured the following eminent artistes:

- Ashok Hazra - Ajmer- has always been fascinated by Lord Krishna, and that is why Krishna becomes a muse for many of his works.
- Somenath Maity - Kolkata- an artist of urban environments and cultures and is called avant-garde and unconventional for his landscapes.
- Anjani Reddy - Hyderabad - eminent painter - creates works of art that are vibrant, nonchalant and true to her surroundings. The women are central in her canvases.
- Paramjeet Singh - Delhi - Bold colours and simplicity are conventional to his themes. Women are central in his canvases.
- Mukul Pawar - Delhi - Sculptor - stones arrange and rearrange themselves in his hands and become an intangible masterpiece.
- Ayushman Mitra - Kolkata - Contemporary Artist - amalgamates his thoughts on the canvas through lines and bold colour.
