

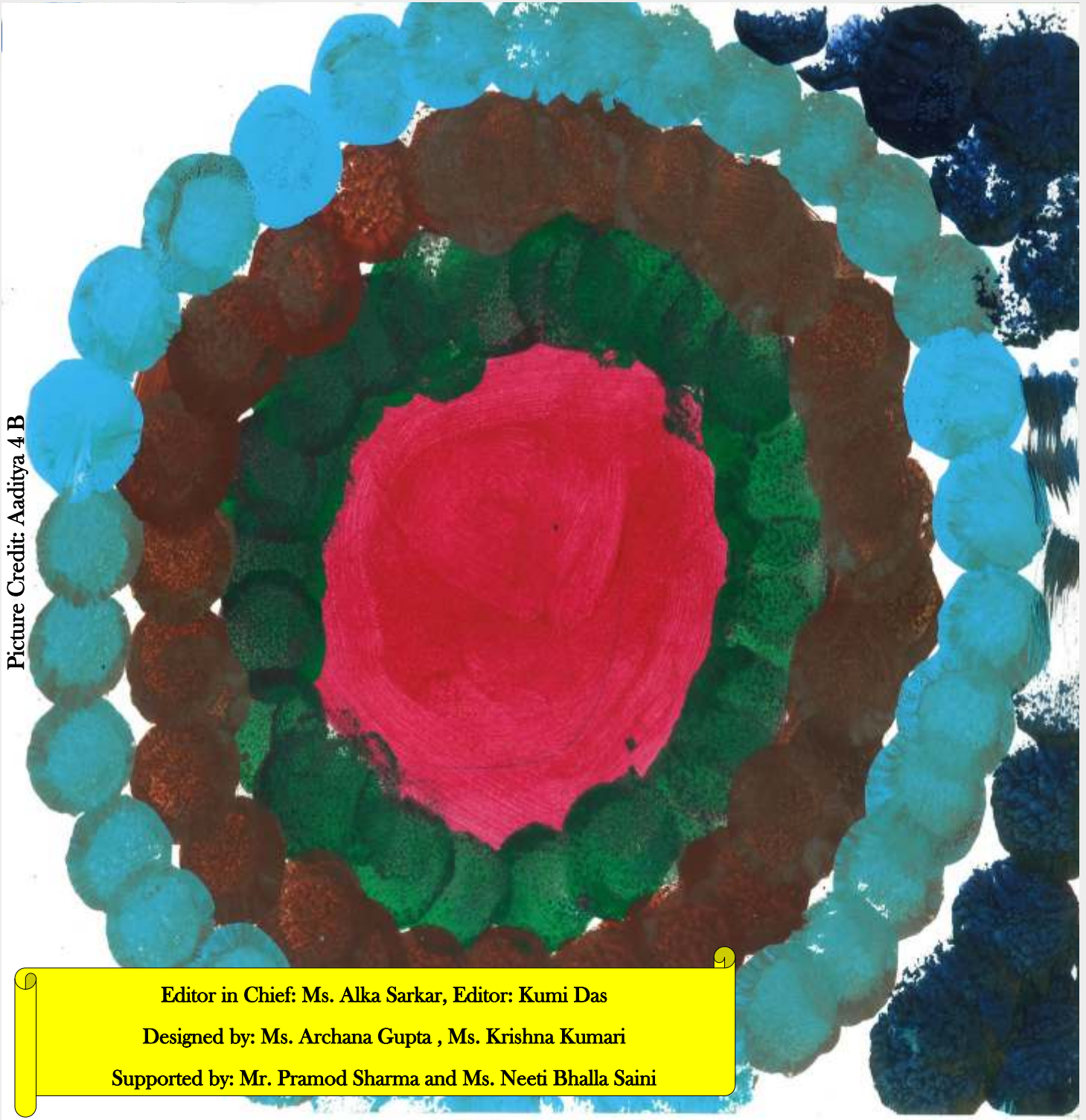

It was decided that we would work towards bringing trees back to the forest and the frog agreed. I stayed the night in the forest and the animals and I talked all night long.

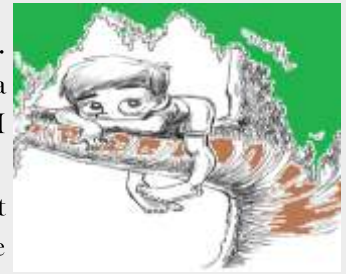
