SELECTION OF STUDENT LEADER & SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

RATIONALE

Student Leaders once identified will become the face of the school and will take up roles of responsibility towards the school community. They will also lead other students by example and promote a culture of empathy, respect, accountability and team work within the school. Some of these exceptional student leaders fulfilling the criteria given below will be awarded a scholarship.

ATTRIBUTES FOR STUDENT LEADERS

COMPETENCE: Necessary skills required to be competent in nearly all areas of school life.

CHARACTER: Demonstrate attitude that relate to moral and ethical strength and behavior including sense of responsibility, accountability and fair play.

CIVILITY: Demonstrate social responsibility towards school and community through commitment and team work.

WORK EXPERIENCE:

Criteria to become Student Leaders -

- Should have been a student of GGS for a minimum of 2 years.
- Exceptional talent and intelligence in a particular area. This may be academic/ Music/arts or literature/ sports.

KINDS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- **A percentage of the school fee.**
- **A one -time study trip/ MUN / RS conference / IB student conference to an assigned place.**
- **The scholarship will be up to a maximum of 50% of the annual school fee.**
- **The scholarship will be available for an academic year only.**
- **A student may apply for a continued scholarship on a condition of an annual review / evaluation of the student.**

Process of Nomination

- 1. The nomination comes from the students as well as the Teachers.**
- 2. A scrutiny committee finalizes the nominations.**
- 3. Nominations are accepted or rejected as per the criteria established by the school.**

Withdrawal of Nomination

Nominated students are allowed to withdraw from the electoral process after satisfactory reasons for the same have been submitted to the CEO.

Process of Election

- 1. The list of nominees is announced by the Chief Electoral Officer.**
- 2. The Nominated candidates are allowed to give their speeches to the electorate.**
- 3. Election is done through secret ballot via online voting (paperless)**
- 4. The electorate consists of the students from grade 9 to 12 for School positions as well as the Teachers.**
- 5. The votes are counted and results announced by the Chief Electoral Officer.**

Appointment

- 1. There is an Investiture ceremony conducted on different days for Junior School and Senior School.**
- 2. Parents are also invited for the ceremony.**
- 3. All appointments are sworn in by the respective Principal by giving certificate and badge.**
- 4. The appointment is for 3 months in junior school and for a year in senior school.**

Who can apply?

- 2018- IB DP Grade 11, IGCSE Grade 10 and IGCSE Grade 9 batch Scholars
- Scholar should have scored a minimum of Grade “B” in all 8 subjects, in 10 IGCSE final examination. The results are declared on 14th August.
- Scholar has met the conditions in the Code of Conduct of the school
- Scholar should have an excellent Service Portfolio with evidences
- Scholar who has achieved excellence in “Creativity”, i.e. in Visual or Design or Performing Arts or Communication in the form of School publications
OR Scholar who has achieved excellence in “Sports”, i.e. in Inter House / Inter School / State level or above

How do you qualify or apply?

- Paper work to apply
 - An application citing your interest in applying for the scholarship.
 - Evidence for the above listed parameters.
- The scholarship aptitude test would be conducted on 18th August for the ones shortlisted based on the Grade 10 IGCSE result.
- Application will then be reviewed by the Principal International Curriculum and DPC.
- Final decision will rest will rest with the School Director.
- Weightage Distribution
 - A - 40 Credits - For Grade 10 IGCSE result.
Each A* = 5 Credits, A = 3 Credits, B = 2 Credits
 - B - 20 Credits - Aptitude Test
 - C - 30 Credits
10 Credits - Code of Conduct
10 Credits - Service Portfolio
10 Credits - Creativity Sports
 - D - 10 Credits - School Director, based on the first 3 parameters.
 - E - Application will then go to Director Operations and School Director for financial approval.

Benefits and Validity

- Scholar with the highest credit score will be given 50% scholarship on the Regular School Fee (Tuition Fee only)
- Scholar with the 2nd highest credit score will be entitled for 25% scholarship on the Regular School Fee (Tuition Fee only)
- Scholar with the 3rd highest credit score will be entitled for 15% scholarship on the Regular School fee (Tuition Fee only)

IPSC Scholarship

The School nominates two exceptional students for IPSC Scholarship in any field of Excellence. (Academic/ Co-curricular/ Sports)

The nominations are screened at the IPSC National Meeting and Scholarships granted as per merit.

It is at the moment INR 40,000/- for a year.

CBSE Academic Scholarship

Class 10 Results

Students scoring 95% and above aggregate shall be eligible for scholarship as approved by the committee comprising the Principal, Director Operations and The School Director.

CBSE Sports Scholarship

Any student shall be eligible for the scholarship if they have played in the national/ International level, provided they have achieved some respectable ranking
