We hope you will enjoy reading the newsletter. Kindly share your inputs on how we can make it more comprehensive as it grows.



As the school prepares to move into the 4th Quarter of the academic year 2018-19, we reflect at the events that have happened in the past year and feel very proud of the way school has moved forward.


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The school also saw a major milestone in the form of CIS pre-evaluation visit in the month of August, helping us to move forward and strengthening our systems and procedures.






