It undertakes disaster relief, humanitarian aid and community development in parts of 23 states across India. Goonj was awarded the Ramon Magsaysay Award in 2015 for their service to the underprivileged community. Their program uses a unique school kit designed by Goonj to promote participation of children. Goonj begins with sessions in urban school followed by a visit to the Goonj centres where they learn about recycling. Urban children contribute their old school supplies to create a school kit which consists of bags, pencils, uniforms etc. Goonj also creates activity centres in village schools and awards the school kits while engaging the children in other activities. Our boarders learnt about the processing of clothes and donated their old clothes to the organization.

Genesis Model United Nations Conference (GGG MUN 2019)

The Genesis MUN 2019 was an extremely successful event that provided a platform for impactful and meaningful learning. The conference commenced on 23rd August. Major General Vikram Dogra, the Chief Guest and the Keynote speaker is the first serving Indian Army officer and the only General in the world to complete the Ironman Challenge in Austria at the age of 58 years in 14 hours and 20 minutes. General Dogra enlightened the audience with leadership acumen and used examples from military history and his personal experiences. He covered various topics in his motivational speech. We also had amongst us the Vice-President Managing Committee and Education luminary, Mr Pramod Sharma. His presence further enhanced the cerebral quotient of the intellectual assemblage.

In this MUN edition, 160 delegates from across 11 schools nationwide engaged in a fruitful debate and stimulated great conversations. With our theme of “Definitive Actions”, we created a simulation of committees, varying from the fast-paced Indian War Cabinet to the compelling Supreme Court, where delegates meaningfully debated and reached well-crafted and thoughtful resolutions which provided them with an experience that transformed them into future leaders and change makers. The hotly contested best school delegation was bagged by The Modern School Barakhamba, while DPS Noida emerged close runners-up. The delegates of Genesis Global School performed tremendously well and bagged the maximum number of awards in this edition of Genesis MUN. The conference ended on August 25th with the closing address by the Principal CBSE, Mr Ajay Singh and vote of thanks by the Chef-de-Cabinet Mr Anoop Singh.
