SUB: - F1 IN SCHOOLS - TRAINING SESSIONS For Grade 8th to 12th (both curriculums)

As an endeavour to promote ‘STEM’ (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) education in our school we try to provide opportunities for our scholars, where they can take thoughtful risks, engage in experiential learning, persist in problem-solving, embrace collaboration, and work through the creative process.

I am pleased to inform you that our scholars who participated in the STEM Programme last year called ‘ F1 in Schools’ were the winners of National Championship and represented India in ‘F1 in Schools World Finals’ at Singapore. Also, this year one of our scholars is a part of the Indian Team which is going for the World Finals at Abu Dhabi next month.

‘F1 in Schools’ is a global multi-disciplinary challenge in which teams of students deploy CAD/CAM software to collaborate, design, analyse, manufacture, test, and then race miniature compressed air powered balsa wood F1 cars. Teams raise sponsorship and manage budgets to fund their research, travel and accommodation. The challenge inspires students to use IT to learn about physics, aerodynamics, design, manufacturing, branding, graphics, sponsorship, marketing, leadership/teamwork, media skills and financial strategy, and apply them in a practical, imaginative, competitive and exciting way.

The training sessions for this year’s ‘F1 in Schools’ competition for the selected scholars from Grades 8 to 12 will begin from **10th October 2019**.

The classes will be conducted by trained teachers from ‘Time of Sports’ on every **Tuesday and Thursday between 3.30 and 5.00 pm. However the school will not provide transport for these afternoon classes.**

The registration fee for the competition is Rs.10,500/- which will include the training, kit and transportation charges for the competition. The teams would be required to pay the additional charges for car printing and pit booth preparation (if they are not able to raise the sponsorships).
