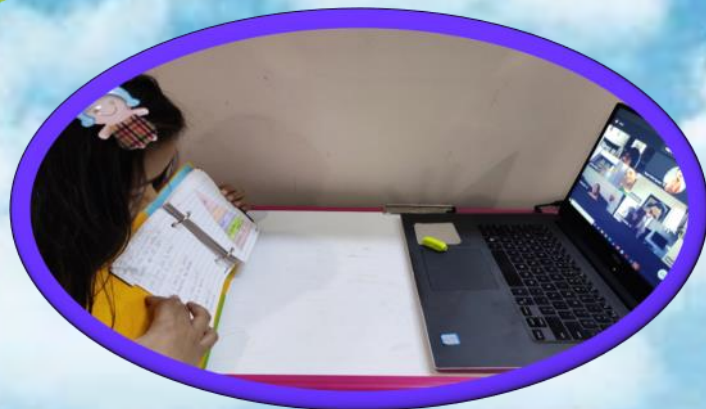

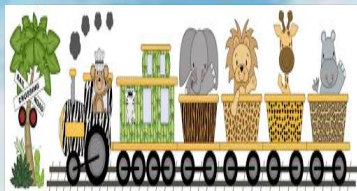

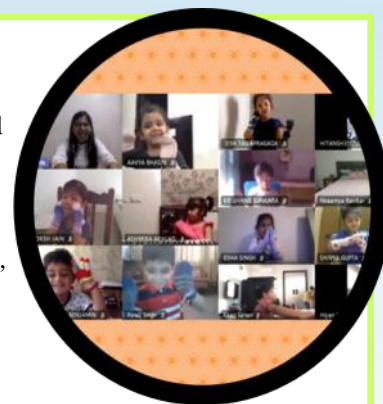
Musical Story By Nursery

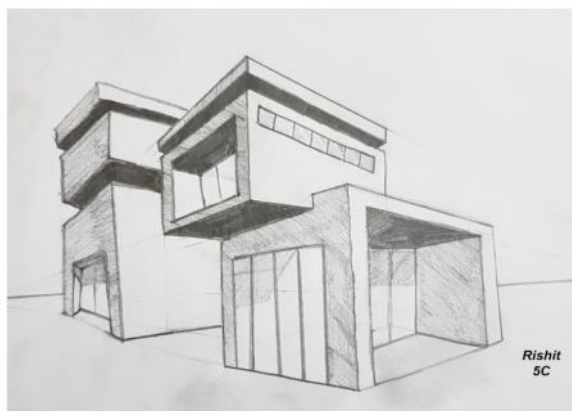

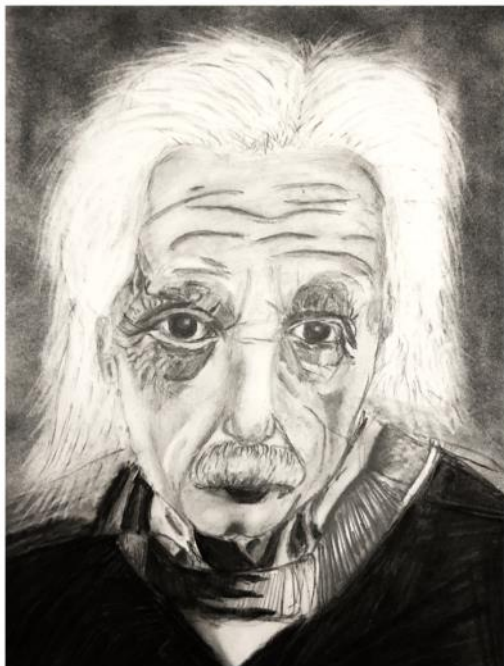
