HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Objective: to ensure the premises is safe for all community members and follows safety standards.

Policy Statement: GGS will complete a safety inspection of each major area of the school on a five-week cycle. Using prescribed checklists inspections and necessary repairs will take place. Teams will be comprised of the members below with the General Manager responsible for coordination, repairs and reporting.

Procedures:

- 1. Establish a Health and Safety Team for each major area of the school.
- 2. Conduct an inspection of each area once per month, as per H & S checklists. One area per week.
- 3. Generate a report that prioritizes any concerns which is passed onto the General Manager and Director
- 4. Complete repairs as required, generate written notice of completion for General Manager and Director
- 5. Catalogue of items are retained for reference.

Team Members: Assignment for teachers can be 1 school year. Teachers may vary based on the area of inspection.
